8.203 Supporting Curricular Programs

The Board of Education of Ogden City School District recognizes the need to establish programs that meet the unique educational needs of students, including programs such as summer school, migrant summer school, youth in custody, applied technology, alternative education, career education, adult education, gifted and talented programs, compensatory (make up) credit, and extended day learning opportunities. Provision of these programs shall be dependent on need and available resources.

It is the policy of the Ogden City School District to adhere to and comply with federal and state laws and rules as they pertain to students with disabilities and the provision of a free, appropriate, public education to all students within the school district's jurisdiction.
